Executive Summary, 2012

Throughout 2012, as represented in this first quarter report, the Here's Help Radio Network (HHRN)¹ will continue its decades-long mission to advocate for the rights, dignity, and comfort of poor and homeless individuals, to encourage care for one another and God's Creation, and to share the good news of Jesus Christ through its radio programming. In particular, HHRN's programming will focus on the specific current needs of the homeless and downtrodden in Saint Louis and throughout Mid-America, informing the public about potential discriminatory practices, and about the struggles of those still reeling from the Great Recession and its so-called recovery. Further programming informs listeners about what they can do to help those in need, what New Life Evangelistic Center is already doing, and what they, and the public at large, can do to ease the burden of rising energy costs through sustainable living techniques.
